### **5.3- The 2022 timeline Presented by H.E. Tia Phalla, Deputy Chair of NAA**

- 3 years more to end AIDS in Cambodia by 2025
- The first strategy on prevention


- In 10-year time from 2010-2020, the new HIV case is decreasing slowly from 1100 to 520 cases,
- The shortage of funding for prevention while domestic funding should be increased from 33-50%,
- The HIV infected person should be identified under enabling environments with support from country system,
- The shift from human right focus to CDP/ICP, 77 communes trained and 9 communes integrating AIDS budget into overall commune plan,
- Strengthen and expand PrEP from 10 to other provinces,
- Each working group has clear action plan and timeline that NAA should take the lead, manage and facilitate, particularly priority determination on time,
- Expand the role of GMC to be assist the strategic working group.

#### **5.4- Conclusion and Recommendation by H.E. Chair**

- The NAA narrow meeting should be organized on 11<sup>th</sup> July 2021 to mainly discuss on country system preparation and health equity fund,
- The great appreciation to all NAA leaders and officials on the first NAA plenary meeting is organized successfully with complete documents on time, full participation from NAA members and active discussion,
- The 2<sup>nd</sup> NAA plenary meeting and NAA congress should be considered at any province,
- The sub-decree on universal precaution of HIV transmission should be reviewed by ministry of justice before sending to the council minister office,
- The preparation of the country system document should make it happened to show national multi-sectoral response in place including the strategic plan to end AIDS by 2025 drafted by Dr Leng,

- NAA secretariat should review only the recommendation that relevant to our contexts,
- We should not be direct to NCHADS but only to oversight and coordinate through NAA technical board,
- The IEC committee should focus on preparing practical message that is easier for target groups to apply appropriately. In addition, means to spread messages should be discussed,
- We should not raise many problems rather than provide solutions,
- The Battambang AIDS committee should share its experience on funding mobilization to the sub-national level,
- The concept notes of country system should be clearly determined the responsible agencies,
- The consistent and well coordination between NAA top management team, NAA secretariat and NAA technical board should be strengthen.


